Jefferson County, AL Awards Black Creek PLC and CCTV Upgrade



Birmingham, AL – September 29, 2015 – Black Creek has been awarded a contract to upgrade the programmable logic controller (PLC) and closed circuit television (CCTV) systems at the Jefferson County Youth Detention Center, located in Birmingham, Alabama. The existing Black Creek security system at the Detention Center has been in use since 1990. Black Creek has been working with Jefferson County since 1988, when the Bessemer Jail was built.

The scope of the work will involve installing a new GE RX3I PLC System, digital video encoders, digital video recording system to provide up to 30 days of online storage, two touchscreen computers for central control, a digital video work station and additional equipment.

Black Creek's <u>recording systems</u> extend the "eyes" of control room officers. Existing or new security cameras are set up in user-configurable display formats on Black Creek's high-resolution LCD touchscreen monitors and can also be accessed over the internet by authorized users. All CCTV feeds are recorded 24/7 for a timespan determined by the facility. Authorized personnel can burn footage to DVD with tamper-revealing security for evidentiary purposes.
