Bergen County, NJ Awards Black Creek Electronic Security System Upgrade



Birmingham, AL – July 29, 2014 - Black Creek has been awarded a contract to upgrade the current closed circuit television (CCTV) system and programmable logic controllers (PLCs) at the Bergen County Jail located in Hackensack, New Jersey. The 1,250-bed facility currently uses [Black Creek's Superdisplay® Touchscreen System](#).

The scope of the work involves installing new GE Fanuc PLC Processors, two 32" LCD tabletop touchscreen monitors, a DVR system with 30 day online storage, and additional equipment.

Existing or new security cameras are set up in user-configurable display formats on Black Creek's high-resolution LCD touchscreen monitors and can be accessed over the internet by authorized users.
